The petitioner has approached this Court being an ex-serviceman for issuance of allotment letter for the plot no.448, Sector 18 (Def), Rewari, which has come to the petitioner in the light of the successful draw of lots held on 16.09.2010. Till date the allotment letter has not been issued to petitioner despite similar writ petition having been decided by this Court including CWP-13630-2012 titled as “Chander Bhan Sharma Vs. Haryana Urban Development Authority and others”, decided on 10.10.2012 (Annexure P-1).

Assertion has also been made that Special Leave Petition was preferred which has also been dismissed by the Supreme Court vide order dated 12.07.2016 (Annexure P-2). Petitioner have been approaching the
