The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.18 dated 30.01.2020 under Sections 452, 354, 323 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 06.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
