Present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to investigate the allegations alleged in FIR No. 530, dated 25.10.2018, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC in a free and fair manner.

Today at the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the present petition was filed in the year 2019, during the pendency of the present petition, investigation has been completed and challan has been submitted and even the charges have been framed though, the evidence is yet to be led in the trial. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a direction is given to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Learned State counsel raises no objection for directing the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Without going into the merits of the cases as well as keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, where as per the allegations alleged, the property belonging to the petitioner was mortgaged in a fraudulent manner by the accused with the Life Insurance Corporation and the petitioner is suffering as of now due to the said act, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one year from the next date of hearing before the trial Court.
