The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioners herein assail the correctness of a resolution of the Gram Panchayat passed on 06.11.1996. Through the aforesaid resolution, the Gram Panchayat had assigned 11 marlas of land for the construction of a community hall namely Bhagwan Parshuram Bhawan. It is not in dispute that after the allotment of land, a building was constructed there. Subsequently, the village came within the jurisdiction of Municipal Corporation, Gurugram. The Corporation has now sanctioned certain amount of money for reconstruction of the aforesaid building, which is a community center, for the welfare of residents of the area. The present writ petition has been filed on

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that although the petitioners are residents of the village but they never came to know about the allotment of the land for community building. He submits that previously there was a simple community building which is now sought to be reconstructed.

The plot in question is being used for community building since 2006. Only a small piece of land was assigned for construction of a community building. This Bench does not find it appropriate to accept the contention of the petitioners that they did not previously know about the assignment of the land for community building. Still further, community building is for the welfare of all the residents of the area. Hence, no ground to issue the writ is made out, on account of delay as well as on merits.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
