The applicant is seeking quashing of order dated 11.02.2020 (P-4), whereby his application for releasing him on eight weeks' parole has been rejected by the District Magistrate, Amritsar.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the State has referred to para 4 and 5 of the affidavit dated 10.02.2021 filed by Hemant Sharma, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, which read as under:-

“4. That after completing the enquiry, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar submitted its report to District Magistrate, Amritsar vide letter No.54963/A-2 dated 25.12.2020 (Annexure R-1/T), in which Parole of petitioner for 06 weeks was duly recommended. Accordingly, Temporary Release Warrant were issued by District Magistrate Amritsar vide Endorsement No. Reader/D.M./1/449 dated 11.01.2021.

5. That in compliance to Release Warrant supra petitioner has been released on Parole for 06 weeks on 12.01.2021. The accused is presently on parole and his date to surrender in Jail is 24.02.2021.”

In view of the above, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
