Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.21 dated 12.01.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Dakha, Police District Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that except the offence under Section 452 IPC, all other offences are bailable. The petitioners are ready to face trial.
