Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No. 2 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 23.03.2021 but due to inadvertence, the same has been mentioned as 15.02.2021 in para 4 of the petition. He prays that the date of marriage be read as 23.3.2021 instead of 15.02.2021.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 6 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger

from respondents No.4 to 6. Their marriage certificate and photographs evidencing their marriage are on record as Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-4, respectively. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 23.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, (Rural) Jalandhar-respondent No. 2.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 2 and 3 only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, (Rural) Jalandhar-respondent No. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, dated 23.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
