In the instant petition, the petitioner herein is seeking a direction to the SHO/IO/Arresting Officer, Police Station City-1, Abohar and City-2 Abohar, District Fazilka to give at least 10 days notice before arrest of the petitioner, if any FIR is registered against the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that on account of party fiction the petitioner is facing several FIRs, as would be evident from Annexures P-2 to P-4. It is contended that on account of said FIRs, he has already lost his job. It is prayed that in case, any other proceedings/FIR is to be registered against him, he be given 10 days notice before his arrest.

Notice of motion to the respondent-State only.

At this stage, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. She states that she is not in a position to dispute the

registration of three FIRs against the petitioner, as they are being pleaded before this court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and deem it appropriate to direct the SHO/IO/Arresting Officer, Police Station City-1, Abohar and City-2 Abohar, District Fazilka to give 10 days notice to the petitioner herein before his arrest as contemplated under Section 41 Cr.P.C., in case, any further FIR is registered against the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
