The petitioner herein seeks the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.0061 dated 07.06.2019 registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Makhan Singh, Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 06.03.2020 as passed by this Court, the petitioner had joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the above-discussed submission of learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner vide the said order dated 06.03.2020, is made

absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
