The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.329 dated 28.12.2019, registered under Sections 323, 307, 341, 34 and 506 of the IPC at Police Station Uchana, District Jind.

The operative part of the order dated 12.03.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-
