Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 2 to 4 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that daughter of the petitioner namely; Manpreet Kaur aged about 23 years, has been missing since 12.03.2021 for which she had approached the concerned authorities, however, no action has been taken so far. It has also been submitted that the petitioner had received a threat through phone *qua* which the authorities concerned were duly intimated.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, Punjab for taking a decision on the representation dated 22.03.2021 (Annexures P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, Punjab is directed to look into the representation dated 22.03.2021 (Annexures P-2) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps/action, if any required in accordance with law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
