The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.47 dated 13.03.2021, under Sections 379, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC (offence under Section 379-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of same locality in which simple injuries were caused. Offence under Section 379B has been added later on.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 31.03.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Narender

Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 31.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
