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RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (ORAL)

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length and when confronted with Clauses 19, 20 and 20.3 of the contract submits that the petitioner has already served the respondents with a legal notice and it may be permitted to serve the respondents with another detailed notice invoking the dispute resolution clauses. He further prays that the respondent-authorities may be directed to look into and decide the aforesaid dispute resolution notice filed by the petitioner in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid statement of learned senior counsel for the petitioner, the petition filed by the petitioner is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to serve the respondents with fresh notice for dispute resolution in terms of the contract entered into between the parties. It goes without saying that in case the petitioner does so, the authorities concerned would take up the matter and take a decision thereon expeditiously in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
