1 By this petition the grievance raised is that a part of the village common land which was reserved for dumping ground is being illegally diverted to make a path for a private person.

2 In our considered opinion, this kind of questions of facts can be taken up by the petitioners in the proceeding to be initiated under the Village Common Lands Act or before the Civil Court and the disputed questions of facts cannot be appreciated by this Court while exercising powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

3 Petition stands dismissed.

4 Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending Civil Misc. Application(s), if any, also stands dismissed.
