The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

This is second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 18.05.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366-A and 506 of IPC and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.
