Quashing of GD No. 26 dated 14.7.2019 registered under Sections 380, 454, 427 IPC in FIR No. 79 dated 7.4.2019 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Division No. 6, Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 12.3.2020, parties were directed to appear before learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned for recording their statements and trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Ludhiana received wherein it is stated that genuine and valid compromise has been entered into between the parties which is without pressure and coercion.

In view thereof, this petition is allowed. GD No. 26 dated 14.7.2019 registered under Sections 380, 454, 427 IPC in FIR No. 79 dated 7.4.2019 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Division No. 6, Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners are hereby quashed.
