Petitioner Nirmal Singh, aged about 26 years, resident of village Khundar Hithar, Mamdot, Ferozepur has brought the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to initiate legal action against private respondent No.4 for forcibly entering his house, breaking open the locks of the rooms and stealing articles therefrom.

According to the petitioner, he had submitted representation dated 20.1.2021, copy Annexure P3 and representation dated 11.3.2021, copy Annexure P4 to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, without evoking any response.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 to 3.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the representations Annexure P3 and P4 of the petitioner and then to take the necessary action in the matter.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents No.1 to 3 would abide by any such order passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the representations Annexure P3 and P4 and to take necessary action in the matter, in accordance with law if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case.
