**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that though the petitioners, who are substantially appointed as Revisors in the Department of Printing and Stationary, Government of Punjab, are being made to work on the post of Revisor on CDC but, despite the fact that they are fully eligible for the regular promotion, the same is not being granted to them and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that once the petitioners have been found eligible to discharge the duties of the post of Reader as current duty, the denial of the regular promotion to the said post is contrary to law and illegal.

The prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for the grant of regular promotion to the post of Reader.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the concerned authority vide representations attached as Annexures P-5 to P-9, which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Sunint Kaur, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representations of the petitioners in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representations Annexures P-5 to P-9, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said representations within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
