1. The instant petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 – Director General of Police, Punjab to transfer investigation pertaining to FIR No.331 dated 14.09.2020 under Sections 336/506/34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, P.S. Division No.8, Ludhiana, outside District Ludhiana as respondent No.6, who is the main conspirator behind the deadly attack against the members of the family of the petitioner, is stated to have earlier remained a Councillor twice and in fact even his wife is a Councillor.
2. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that an identical petition had been filed earlier by the

petitioner i.e. CRM-M-4207-2021, wherein the following directions were issued on 29.01.2021:

“Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards merits of the case or as regards the veracity of averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5-Commissioner of Police, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana to look into the matter and to ensure that the matter in hand is got investigated fairly and expeditiously in accordance with law, so that a final report is submitted thereafter at the earliest.”

3. Faced with the aforestated position, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to get some SIT constituted for investigation of the matter, as requested by him in his representation dated 12.01.2021.
4. In view of the aforesaid submission, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Director General of Police, Punjab to consider the representation dated 12.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) and to dispose of the same in accordance with law.
