HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.07 dated 10.02.2021, under Sections 326, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

The FIR was registered on the complaint of Harjinderjit Kaur, who stated that on 26.01.2021 at about 06:00 p.m., she was present at her house. Sadhu Singh-Petitioner armed with Datar, Palwinder Singh @ Buta armed with Dang, Jaswinder Singh @ Ashoka armed with Baseball, Sukhwinder Kaur alongwith two unidentified persons came towards her house and raised lalkara. On this she came out of the house. Sukhwinder Kaur shouted that the complainant be caught and taught a lesson. Then Petitioner gave datar blow on the left arm elbow of the complainant; Palwinder Singh @ Buta pushed her and she fell down. Then Jaswinder Singh @ Ashoka gave baseball blow. The accused persons gave severe beatings to the

complainant and dragged her on the ground. On noise being raised by the complainant, all the accused person ran away from the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in respect of the same incident the accused persons has also filed a criminal complaint. Palwinder Singh has suffered gun shot injury. He further submits that the present FIR was lodged after delay of about 15 days. It is a case of version and cross version. He also submits that the petitioner is being falsely implicated because the petitioner has been cited as witness in some criminal complaint.

Notwithstanding the aforesaid contention what clearly comes out is that as per the MLR of the complainant, the injury said to be inflicted by the petitioner is grievous in nature. Therefore, no ground is made out to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition dismissed.
