The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to restore the family pension to the petitioner and for certiorari quashing the order dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) and seeking redressal of the grievance of the petitioner, application/representation dated 15.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the application dated 15.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
