1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari/Mandamus by giving the direction to the respondents to consider the representations of the petitioner and also set aside the impugned order dated 23.2.2021 (Annexure-6).

2. A complaint was made by the petitioner regarding invalid votes report of the booth level officer was obtained by the Electoral Registration Officer, 05-Ambala City Assembly Constituency and Sub Divisional Officer (No.), Near Ambala City. It was found that 84 votes had to be deleted while 38 votes were found to be of persons who were residing at the addresses mentioned and consequently, those votes were directed to be retained. The petitioner by this petition has claimed that in fact there are even now 27 other persons who are not residing at the mentioned address. However, in the writ petition the number is

mentioned as 55.

3. Be that as it may, we find that the factual exercise has been conducted by the respondent No.3 and it is not possible for this Court to embark on this issue of fact.

4. Petition stands dismissed.

5. Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending application if any stands disposed of.
