Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118 dated 15.02.2020, registered under Sections 379, 406, 420 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal.

On 12.03.2020, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while purchasing the tractor, he had deposited a sum of Rs.45,000/- and for the remaining amount he had applied for a loan and submitted all the requisite documents with the representatives of the finance company with whom the complainant had a tie-up. The petitioner was assured that the loan amount will be processed. On that assurance, he had taken the physical possession of the tractor. He submits that offences under Sections 379, 406 and 420 of IPC are not made out.

Notice of motion for 27.05.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaipal, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that he is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
