Application is allowed as prayed for.

Main case

By means of this writ petition under Articles 226 Constitution of India, petitioners have prayed for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as petitioners have solemnized marriage against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the statement of Ranjit Singh (father of petitioner No.1), a case FIR No.62

dated 24.03.2021 under Sections 346 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala (Annexure P-6) stands registered against petitioner No.2. As per the allegations, petitioner No.2 enticed away daughter of respondent No.4. Learned counsel submits that the case is under investigation.

After hearing the learned counsel and considering the above background, this Court finds that respondent No.4 has adopted a lawful process by making a complaint to the Police, therefore, the apprehension of the petitioners regarding threat from the relatives of petitioner No.1 is misplaced.

Since the FIR has already been registered against petitioner No.2, therefore, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
