Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner for the post of Lab Technician in National Health Mission, in view of the fact that the benefit has already been granted to the similarly situated candidates.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that instead of pressing the petition on merits, he would be satisfied in case representation dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-9) is decided by the competent authority, expeditiously.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and he is not averse for the innocuous prayer made by the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2- The Mission Director, National Health Mission, Panchkula, to consider and decide representation dated 09.02.2021

(Annexure P-9) if the same is pending, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of two months from today.
