Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.229 dated 26.12.2020, under Section 5/13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Bichhore, District Nuh, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that 12 cows were being transported and the petitioner is stated to have run away from the spot. He, however, contends that it is not possible for the petitioner to have run away in the presence of several police officials. The cattle were found to be unharmed.

This Court, by the order dated 26.05.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Naresh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 26.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
