JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed for grant of extension of parole on the ground that mother-in-law of the petitioner is on her death bed because of last stage of cancer.

Counsel for the petitioner would rely upon medical condition of mother-in-law of the petitioner by referring to Annexure P-1, which is a report of Chadha Hospital as well as a report given by Paras Hospital, Panchkula.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the reports of the hospitals, with the assistance of learned State counsel.

The medical report of Chadha Hospital cannot be relied upon

because it does not reflect that the mother-in-law of the petitioner is suffering from cancer, however, the second report as presented of Paras Hospital would indicate Sarcoma and Lymphoma. But, the said report of Paras Hospital itself does not indicate that the mother-in-law, aged 85 years, is on death bed, as claimed by the petitioner.

In such circumstances, this court is not inclined to allow extension of parole to the petitioner at the given time. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application at a proper time.
