This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and to take action on representations dated 16.02.2021, 15.03.2021 and 17.03.2021 (Annexures P-1 to P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 16.02.2021, 15.03.2021 and 17.03.2021 to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Anandpur Sahib, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nangal Township and Senior Superintendent of Police, Nangal Township, copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/1 to P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Nangal Township, District Rupnagar, to look into and decide representation dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
