The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the payment for the acquisition by which the respondents had acquired his land in Khasra number 3588/2 along with house at Village Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra, Haryana, has not been released to him and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appropriate directions be issued to the respondent-authorities to release the compensation awarded in favour of the petitioner along with the interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the writ petition, the petitioner has already submitted number of representations starting from Annexure P-1. The latest representation which the petitioner has

submitted is on 03.02.2021 (Annexure P-4) which is still pending consideration with respondent No. 2 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No. 2 at this stage to decide the representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State Counsel raises no objection for the grant of prayer of deciding representation (Annexure P-4) dated 03.02.2021 by respondent No. 2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim raised by the petitioner in the present petition or in the representation(s), the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 03.02.2021 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order by passing appropriate speaking order.

In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same be also released in his favour within a period of one month thereafter.

Ordered accordingly.
