The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing order dated 22.10.2019 as passed by Ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar whereby, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in complaint case No.6243/2018 titled as *Avtar Singh vs. Bishan Dass*.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner herein submits that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial court and join the proceedings, with the prayer that arrest of the petitioner be stayed for a limited period in order to enable him to surrender before the trial court and move an application for grant of regular bail, which application may be considered and decided by the trial court expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Arrest of the petitioner herein is stayed limited for a period of one week from today, with a direction to him to surrender before the trial court within the stipulated period and move the appropriate application for grant of bail before the trial court, which application will be considered and decided by the trial court, in accordance with law, within two days thereafter. In case, the petitioner herein fails to surrender before the trial court within the stipulate period, any interim protection allowed to him will stand automatically vacated.

The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
