Present petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 122 dated 07.10.2015, under section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

Vide order dated 24.02.2021 while rejecting the cancellation report filed by the police, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga took cognizance under Section 190 (1) (b) Cr.P.C. and summoned the petitioner for 18.03.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the next date for appearance of the petitioner before learned trial Court is 23.04.2021. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before learned trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into account the facts of the present case, this petition is disposed of with the observation that the petitioner may appear before the learned trial Court 23.04.2021. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by the trial Court subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction. He shall also file an undertaking to continue appearing before the Court as and when required apart from following all the terms and conditions fixed in this respect.
