The appellant is an elected counsellor of BJP from Ward No. 20, Municipal Corporation Batala. In the light of alleged incident of 09.02.2021 wherein the appellant is stated to have been attacked by an armed person who was dressed as a Nihang, the appellant apprehending threat to his life and in the welfare of his family, moved Civil Writ Petition No. 4720 of 2021 before this Court seeking protection. The said writ petition seeking protection has been disposed of vide impugned judgment dated 01.03.2021 passed by learned Single Judge, whereby the petitioner has been relegated to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala for redressal of his grievance, who in turn, based on the threat perception, is required to take steps, if warranted, in accordance with law. Hence, the present appeal assailing the order dated 01.03.2021 passed by learned Single Judge.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the appellant submits that in spite of the petitioner having approached the SSP concerned on 10.03.2021, no action/decision has been taken or conveyed to the appellant.

Keeping in view the limited scope of interference by this Court in Letters Patent Appeal, learned counsel for the appellant prays for permission to withdraw the present LPA with liberty to pursue his representation filed before the SSP concerned.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

It is hoped that the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala would take necessary action in accordance with law and convey the same to the appellant at the earliest.
