Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action on the DDR No. 13 dated 20.10.2019 and to initiate criminal proceedings against respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

A perusal of the record shows that the DDR was registered with the allegations that the accused persons have given some *daah* blow to the petitioner.

Reply, by way of the affidavit of the DSP, Phul, Bathinda, is filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.

In reply, after giving the details of the contents of the DDR, it is stated that as per investigation, it is found that Mohan Kumar @ Mana-respondent No. 4 had sold two acres of land to petitioner Chand Singh about 30-35 years ago and executed the agreement but due to some reason, sale deed could not be executed. Later on, Chand Singh, by changing the date of agreement, has filed a civil suit against Mohan Kumar @ Mana and the case

is pending before the High Court and on that pretext, petitioner Chand Singh used to quarrel with Mohan Kumar @ Mana. It is further stated that Mohan Kumar @ Mana was standing on his land taken on rent at Kesar Singh Wala and then Chand Singh along with 3-4 boys quarreled with him, however, the people of the nearby area intervened and stopped them. In that process, Chand Singh and Mohan Kumar @ Mana has received no injury and by giving a self inflicted injury, petitioner Chand Singh has got himself admitted in a hospital, therefore, no further action was taken by the police.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to file a complaint before the Illaqua Magistrate, if so advised.
