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MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with their junior-respondent No.6.

At the outset, instead of pressing the petition, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the legal notice dated 17.12.2020 (Annexure P-8) is decided by the competent authority, expeditiously.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only, at this stage.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and she is not averse for the innocuous prayer made by the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Punjab to consider and decide the legal notice dated 17.12.2020 (Annexure P-8) if the same

is pending, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from today.
