At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the pleas, as have been raised herein, before the trial Court at the stage of framing of charges including their plea to the effect that in the absence of any complaint by the first wife, no offence under Section 494 IPC could have been added in the FIR.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioners raise any objection/plea before the trial Court at the stage of framing of charges, the trial Court shall dispose of the same by passing a speaking order.
