In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that their pension has not been fixed by the respondents in accordance with law and they are being granted less pension though, as per the petitioners, they are entitled for basic pension of Rs.70,450/- plus dearness allowance w.e.f. 01.01.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have already served upon the respondent No.1 with a legal notice dated 22.02.2021 (Annexure P/3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Kumar Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding legal notice dated 22.02.2021 (Annexure P/3) served by the petitioners in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners, the respondent No.1 is directed to decide legal notice dated 22.02.2021 (Annexure P/3) served by the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
