In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of 1st ACP on completion of 10 years of service which he completed on 01.10.2013 as well as 2nd ACP on completion of 16 years of regular service which he completed on 01.10.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is fully eligible for the grant of the said benefit but the same is not being extended to him and that too without any valid justification. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present writ petition, has also been raised by issuance of the legal notice-cum-demand notice dated 22.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) and in reply to the said notice, it has already been mentioned by the respondents that the claim of the petitioner has already been sent to the District Education Officer for the consideration but no final decision has been taken

so far, which act of the respondents is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the legal notice dated 22.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 22.01.2021 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
