By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to respondent no.3 to take action on his complaint/representation dated 03.06.2019.

Today, finally, counsel for the petitioner has put in an appearance after not having come present on two dates in succession, with this court having put a query to him on April 6, 2021, which he was unable to answer.

Be that as it may, since his only contention at this stage is that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the SSP, Roopnagar, to decide his representation (copy Annexure P-4), as has been contended to have been made on 03.06.2019, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the SSP, Roopnagar, (respondent no.3), to look into the grievance of the petitioner and to take any action as may be warranted as per law, within a period of three months from the date of a receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is made absolutely clear that this court has made no

observation on the merits of what has been contended either in the representation or in this petition, which would be something that the SSP would be required to go into.
