1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn while directing the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a stipulated period of time in view of the long incarceration of the petitioner i.e. more than three years.

3. The limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed to by the learned State Counsel.

4. In the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn while directing the learned trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months in view of the fact that seven out of nine prosecution witnesses have already been examined as per stand of learned State counsel.
