The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0024 dated 13.02.2021, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326, 308, 325 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

The operative part of the order dated 05.04.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-
