The petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been filed for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of petitioners from private respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are interfering in their peaceful possession of the property.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioners acquired the possessory rights in the property in question through a lease executed by respondent No.4 (owner of property) and suit for possession filed by the respondent No.4, against the petitioners is already pending. Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed reliance upon the lease deed dated 20.08.2020 to set up an apprehension that private respondents and lessee are threatening to dis-possess them forcibly.

Apparently, the petitioners have an alternative remedy available with them, therefore, no case is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
