(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioners, claiming themselves to be aged about 18 and 27 years respectively, have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the averments that the petitioners performed marriage on 25.03.2021 at Gurudwara Shri Amar Darbar, Shergarh Katcha Road, Mohalla Akash Colony, Hoshiarpur as per Sikh rites and ceremonies against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 7 and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Learned Counsel for respondents No.5 to 7 has filed copy of his power of attorney through e-mail print out of which is taken on record. Original power of attorney be filed in the Registry of this Court.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that statement of

petitioner No.1 was recorded by the police and in view of her statement offence punishable under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "the IPC") was added to the FIR No.67 dated 25.03.2021 registered under Sections 366 and 120-B of the IPC and petitioner No.2 has been arrested in the case and petitioner No.1 has gone with her father respondent No.5.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners has acknowledged this factual position to be correct and has submitted that he does not have any further instructions.

In view of the subsequent developments in the case as brought to the notice of this Court by learned State Counsel and not disputed by learned Counsel for the petitioners, no further action is required to be taken on the present petition which is disposed of as having become infructuous.
