Case taken up through video conferencing.

On 01.04.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is nowhere named in the FIR and that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused on the basis of a disclosure statement made by co-accused and that even as per the said disclosure statement, the petitioner is attributed fist blows only. It has further been submitted that in the instant case offence under Section 307 IPC, in any case, has been deleted.

Notice of motion for 27.7.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal

bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gian Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but danda is yet to be recovered.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
