This application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for preponing the date of hearing of the main petition, which is already fixed for 27.11.2021.

Notice of application.

At the asking of Court, learned State counsel accepts notice and stated that he has no objection if application is allowed.

In view of the grounds mentioned in the application and no objection by learned State counsel, hearing of the main petition is preponed and is taken on Board today itself.

CRM is allowed.

Main Case

Status report dated 15.06.2021 by way of affidavit of Sandeep Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Madlauda, District Panipat along with Annexures R/1 and R/2, already filed on behalf of respondent-State, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Krishan Kumar submits that in compliance of order dated 31.03.2021, petitioner has already joined investigation in case FIR No.292 dated 29.07.2020, under Sections 120-B, 342, 364-A, 379-A IPC read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 201, 323, 341, 379-B, 384 and 387 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat, and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation. He further submits that as such instant petition seeking quashing of impugned order dated 03.03.2021 (Annexure P/9) be disposed of having become infructuous.

Faced with this situation, order dated 31.03.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

In view of above, instant petition seeking quashing of impugned order dated 03.03.2021 (Annexure P/9) moved by the petitioner is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
