Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sonapat, to expedite/conclude the trial in case bearing FIR No.264 dated 06.07.2013, registered at Police Station Sonapat Sadar, District Sonapat, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 452 and 506 IPC.

Copy of explanation report dated 01.07.2021, by way of affidavit of the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has been pending before the trial Court for the last 08 years and only 09 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far. The petitioner has been appearing before the trial Court on each and every date.

Perusal of the explanation report would submit that out of 17 prosecution prosecution, 08 witnesses are yet to be examined; that one of co-accused, namely, Shiv Kumar, absented himself from the court

proceedings and due to this reason, the remaining witnesses could not be examined; that now, the aforesaid co-accused has been apprehended and sent to the judicial custody, and that remaining witnesses will appear before the trial Court on priority basis.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the aforesaid case at the earliest.
