The plaintiff-petitioner has filed this revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, assailing the correctness of the order passed by the learned trial court as well as the First Appellate Court while dismissing his application for grant of temporary injunction. Both the courts have found that the land is lying vacant and the respondent-Gram Panchayat claims it to be a part of the street. Thus, the courts have held that even if the plaintiff ultimately succeeds, the relief sought for cannot be secured. Still further, in the absence of any perversity or any material irregularity in the order, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere.

Hence, dismissed.
