Challenge in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the order dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1 under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007.

During the proceedings dated 11.11.2020, the matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and settlement dated 22.12.2020 has been arrived at between the parties. As per the terms and conditions of the same, Rs.15 lakhs is payable to the petitioner-wife subject to certain terms and conditions, regarding the litigation pending inter se the parties. It has further been agreed that the petitioner would also withdraw the present petition which is pending before this Court, as per clause 7 of the settlement.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, in view of the settlement arrived at, between the parties.
