Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.190, dated 29.9.2019, having been registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 324/34 of the IPC (with Sections 307/326 of the IPC having been added later).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhmander Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 31.3.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be

given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon them.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he/she would be always at liberty to avail of his/her remedy as per law.
