ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner prays for an anticipatory bail in FIR No.22 dated 16.2.2020 under Sections 323/325/341/506/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Machroli, District Jhajjar.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court, vide order dated 16.3.2020, had granted ad interim bail to the petitioner:-

“ Notice of motion for 21.07.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;***
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly***

make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;

3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court. To be heard along with CRM-M-10762-2020 . ”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sant Kumar, submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation, pursuant to order dated 16.3.2020 (*ibid*), and is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

In the wake of the above, the order dated 16.3.2020 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
