This petition has been filed by Shekhar Rana seeking permission to visit Canada and also for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release his passport, which had been taken into possession by the police during investigation of the case i.e. FIR No.827 dated 29.5.2017, under Sections 323, 354, 406, 420, 467, 498-A IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Since the petitioner and the complainant and all other accused

have amicably resolved their issue and in fact vide separate order of even date passed by this Court in CRM-M-16605 of 2018, the FIR has been quashed on the basis of compromise, the instant petition merits acceptance and is hereby accepted. The passport of the petitioner, which is stated to have been taken into possession during the course of investigation is ordered to be released to the petitioner.

Since, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that the passport was forwarded to the Court alongwith the challan, the Court concerned is directed to release the passport of the petitioner subject to proper identification of petitioner. The petitioner will be at liberty to visit any country of his choice provided he is not wanted in any other case, or is otherwise not debarred in any manner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
